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WINE

The second vintage of the Five H Heritage is a blend of eight different grape varieties all harvested, and fermented together, a process called "Field Blend". The Hinman family was intrigued by this method, and this blend of Heritage met the standards we expect for a Five H wine.

The Wahluke Wine Company in Mattawa, Washington produced the wine, and Five H stabilized, aged, and bottled Heritage at our Eugene, Oregon winery.

The field blend process, an old world method of fermenting different grapes together, is a significant departure from the traditional individual grape fermentation. The flavor profile of this wine demonstrates the unmatched unique tasting component of which is a signature of Five H Heritage.

We're pleased to offer this quality red wine blend that not only compliments our white riesling, and Walla Walla syrah, but also represents the Hinman families *heritage* in both style and distinctiveness.
